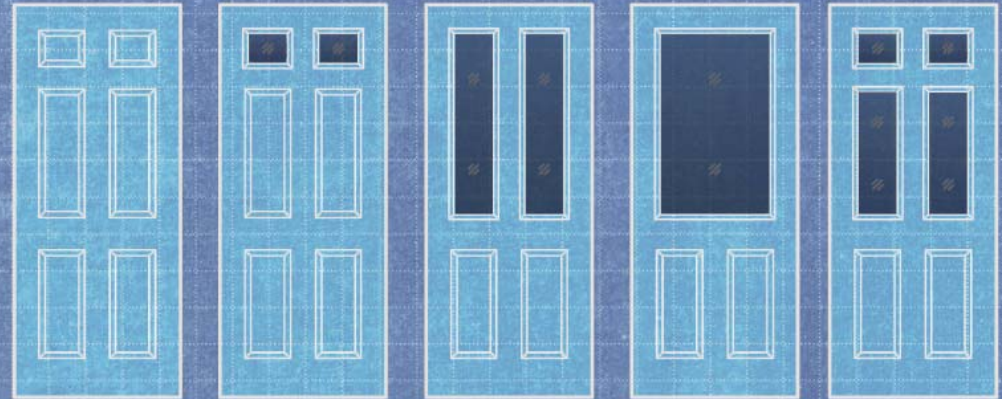

For products to be eligible they must first be successfully tested to PAS23, a performance standard which shows that a door is fit for purpose, and PAS24, which involves a series of additional security performance tests that are based on popular methods of attack using a set range of tools within a specific timescale. As part of the process to ensure that products are continually manufactured to these high standards we also offer Doorsets certified under the BM Trada Enhanced Security Doorsets Certification Scheme.

Specific doorsets have been independently tested by an independent UKAS accredited test facility, to confirm compliance with:

PAS 23 -1:1999: General performance requirements for door assemblies – weather, durability and life cycle testing.

PAS 24 -1:1999: Enhanced security performance requirements for door assemblies – resistance to opportunistic attack.

Secure By Design: Members' products must comply with the above performance criteria to allow incorporation within this scheme which is managed and funded by the Association of Chief of Police Officers Crime Prevention Initiatives (ACPO CPI Ltd.).
