Doorsets and Doorkits are the way forward

The last decade has seen a shift for housebuilders from the traditional method of purchasing and building internal doors to buying them as doorsets or doorkits. Traditionally a builder would be using three or more suppliers to provide the items required and a skilled joiner would cut the linings to size, mortice for hardware, trim the doorleaf if required, and hang the door. The advent of doorsets and kits meant there could be just one supplier and all the components would be ready machined and fitted for putting together on site with simple tools, no cutting or trimming required.

Later this year we should see the full suite of pedestrian doorset European standards available and products can be CE marked. EN14351-1 has been around for a few years now and we have already seen external non-fire doorsets CE marked on the UK market. But we shall soon see internal non-fire doorsets CE marked to EN14351-2 and fire doorsets CE marked to EN16034.

CE marking of doorsets will be mandatory, so if a door is supplied as a doorset or in kit form then it should be CE marked. There are those who will try to find the loop-holes and omit an essential component, or not machine for something which would mean it is classed as a door assembly and cannot be CE marked. However we at Ian Firth Hardware Ltd strongly recommend CE marked doorsets/ kits are specified by our customers as it gives them many advantages over the traditional route. Many builders are already realising the benefits of doorsets/ kits without even considering the CE marking aspect, as they basically saves time and ultimately cost.

The obvious benefit is that fitting doorsets/kits is more accurate and much quicker than the traditional assembly method. Labour time per doorset is reduced so saves costs for the builder. However some builders have switched door installation from skilled joiners to semi-skilled labourers. The danger here is that they wrongly assume that as a door comes as a doorset or in kit form they have abdicated some or all the responsibility to ensure it is fitted correctly. We know what the accurate installation of a doorframe or lining is essential to the correct operation of the doorset especially fire resting doorsets which has the potential to save lives. Therefore we must strive to encourage builders to continue to employ skilled joiners to hang doorsets to ensure the product performs as intended.



- **8.** Snap the door leaves onto the hinges and fit the handles. Adjust the hinges for a perfect fit and job done!!





Patented quicksemble adjustable, snap-in hinge system

Hinge cradles are secured to the door frame with the corresponding hinge receivers fitted to the door leaf. Installation, or hanging of the door, is then carried out simply by 'snapping' the door receivers onto the hinge jamb. Once in place the relative door position can be adjusted to ensure an optimum fit within the doorframe.

- to be moved up or down +/- 2.5mm (This feature only applies to 3D hinges)
- Horizontal adjustment allows the door to be moved left or right +/-
- Lateral adjustment allows the door to be moved in or out of the doorframe rebate +/- 2.5mm
- Suitable for: 34 and 44mm thick doors

Adjust the hinge: Laterally, To move the door in and out.



Adjust the hinge: Vertically, To move the door up or down. (3D only)


